


Supervision of antenna installation

I graduated from the University of Vermont in 1971. I earned a FCC First Class Radiotelephone Operator license in 1974, and I hold lifetime General Radiotelephone License PG-1-1254. I have been involved in construction, maintenance and operation of radio and television transmitters continuously since 1972. I have been employed as a broadcast engineer by Vermont Public Radio since 2003, and was employed by Vermont Public Television from 1972 to 2003. I have also worked as a contract engineer since 1974.

On September 15 and 16, 2008 the WVTI antenna was installed. On September 17, 2008 Patricia S. Kules, L.S., a Vermont Licensed Land Surveyor, verified that the azimuth of the antenna is 270 degrees True North, the elevation at the center of radiation is 12.5 meters above ground, and the NAD27 coordinates are: N 44 47 02, W 71 53 13.

When the antenna was installed, and again when the surveyor verified the position, azimuth, and elevation. I was on site and supervised the installation and the measurements.
