**Re: Waiver of Construction Deadline for Construction Permit
BNPFT-20130826AHC**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Community Translator Network, LLC – Debtor-In-Possession (“CTN”) and Salem Media of Oregon, Inc. (“Salem”) filed an assignment application with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) on July 28, 2016, seeking to assign the construction permit for unbuilt FM Translator Station K294CP, Roseburg, Oregon (Facility ID No. 142743) from CTN to Salem (File No. BAPFT-20160728AGM), which was granted on January 4, 2017.

Salem filed a “250 Mile Modification” application for K294CP on July 29, 2016 (File No. BMPFT-20160729AMX). The purpose of the modification is to allow Salem to rebroadcast KPDQ (AM), Portland, Oregon, on the translator. After consummation and grant of the modification application, Salem will build the translator promptly.

While CTN’s counsel filed a tolling request on December 15, 2014, CDBS reflects that the K294CP Construction Permit is currently scheduled to expire on January 9, 2017. Salem accordingly requests a waiver of the construction deadline for the Construction Permit pursuant to Footnote 36 of the FCC’s October 23, 2015 “AM Revitalization” Order, FCC 15-142, for six months from the later of the consummation of the assignment or the FCC grant of the above-referenced modification application. Salem also requests that any remaining time on the K294CP Construction Permit term as a result of tolling be added in as well.
