Subject: STA FOR KFPB

Hi Mohammad,

I was able to speak with my client regarding the STA request for KFPB. It turns out there are site related problems where the STA on file is requested so what he would like to do is to request a different STA at the location indicated in the analog displacement application 20080801AMB which has received its CP . This will be an STA for digital operation. It will use the same antenna as the analog CP. Before he files a new STA requesting the different location, though, we discussed the issue of Mexican coordination and have a suggestion. The suggestion is to seek a power level that replicates the coverage area that the analog CP provides. This is put forth in recognition of the fact that Mexico has already agreed with the analog CP. As long as the digital contour does not exceed the analog contour, no interference should exist, (it should actually be less because of the noise-like signal properties of DTV versus the carriers associated with an analog signal). So the hope is that the FCC could grant a digital STA for the equivalent coverage area (since the same antenna pattern is being used) of the analog CP already granted without going through Mexican coordination.

Please let me know if this is an acceptable solution and I will get a new STA filed for the correct new location and power level. If it is not acceptable can you please tell me why or what might be done in order make it acceptable.
