TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Tama Radio Licenses of Savannah, GA, Inc. ("Tama"), licensee of WMZD, Channel 261C2, Statesboro, Georgia. Tama also holds an outstanding permit to upgrade WMZD to Channel 261C1 and implement a change in community of license to Rincon, Georgia (BPH-20030702AAE). Tama herein proposes to modify the outstanding permit by relocating the facility to a new site and downgrading to Channel 261C2 at Rincon, Georgia. It is noted that the licensed facilities of WMZD are presently silent, due to a loss of the station's transmitter site. Therefore, it is respectfully requested that this instant modification be expedited to allow WMZD to restore service.

Tama proposes to locate the antenna system for WMZD on a new tower. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") was apprised of this proposal. Once the FAA issues a Determination of No Hazard, the tower will be registered with the FCC. It is noted that due to the location of the proposed WMZD facility in close proximity to another FM station, Tama could not use of the worksheets associated with FCC Form 301 to certify compliance with the radio frequency radiation rules. As such, attached as Exhibit A, is a study which shows the proposed WMZD facility is in compliance with the RF limits.

This proposal seeks to downgrade WMZD to Channel 261C2 at Rincon, Georgia. At the site proposed in this instant application, Channel 261C2 meets the Commission's minimum distance separation requirement to all other licensed, proposed or applied for facilities; provides a 70 dBu signal to all of Rincon, Georgia; and the tower site is suitable for tower construction. All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to Tama and is available to the Commission upon request.
