Dear Ms. Dortch,

The outstanding Construction Permit for K204EV issued June 7, 2002 contains as condition #2, the requirement for "before and after" measurements per 73.154(a) on the antenna pattern of omni directional broadcast station KYLT(AM), 1kW, Missoula, MT. The K204EV translator has been installed on an existing 60 foot metal tower, located several feet from KYLT and owned by Fisher Radio Regional Group, Inc., also owner of KYLT AM. Direct Measurements were last granted to KYLT November 20, 2001. The antenna structure was constructed by Fisher Radio without any apparent effect to KYLT and no effect has been reported by KYTL since the construction of K204EV. The transmission line is ½ " Andrew LDF-4 hardline with a vertical run of approximately 35-40 feet, bonded to, and mounted on this 60 foot steel communications tower. Due to the near identical nature of the transmission line run for the tower, and given that the transmission line is electrically bonded to the tower in several places, electrically breaking up the line, making it unlikely to be a re-radiator of medium waves, the transmission line is likely to have no effect on the AM omni-directional pattern and further study shouldn't be necessary. Since the stipulation states conditions that do not apply to licensee, namely, the construction of the tower, (but rather the attachment of electrically identical transmission line to an existing steel tower), then the stipulation, for that reason alone, should be removed. Taking into account of all the aforementioned reasons, Calvary Chapel of Twin Falls, Inc. respectfully requests the removal of the special operating conditions from the construction permit and the subsequent grant of the license application for K204EV, Missoula, MT.
