

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

The KLVP Construction Permit (file number BPED-20130909ABM) contains several Special Operating Conditions, summarized as follows:

1. The Automatic Program Test provisions of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1620 do not apply; a formal request for Program Test Authority must be filed in conjunction with FCC Form 302-FM before Program Tests will be authorized.
2. The permittee/licensee must provide the results of proper radiofrequency electromagnetic (RF) field strength measurements throughout the transmitter site area to determine if there are any areas that exceed the FCC guidelines for human exposure to RF fields.
3. The permittee/licensee must provide documentation demonstrating compliance with the preceding special operating condition.
4. Before program tests commence, the permittee shall make and submit to the FCC sufficient measurements to establish that the operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements.
5. The permittee shall submit a copy of the vertical plane radiation pattern for the beam tilt antenna with the FCC Form 302-FM Application for License.
6. Waiver of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 was granted to allow operation of the facility authorized by this construction permit as a satellite operation of station KLVR(FM), Middletown, CA (FIN 18801).
7. Notwithstanding the grant of this construction permit or the expiration date specified herein, your station's license will automatically expire as a matter of law on July 27, 2014 if the station has not resumed broadcasting before that time.
8. The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

1. The instant application constitutes a formal request for Program Test Authority.
