This is in response to the letter dated May 13, 2014 regarding our above-referenced pending application for a new LPFM station at Monticello, Mississippi. The FCC's letter inquires about our efforts to comply with the Environmental Policy Act, and we are required to submit a Progress Report every 30 days. This supplements our prior progress report letters that were submitted by counsel to the FCC staff on May 27, 2014 and June 20, 2014.

On June 18, 2014 a representative from Dynamic Environmental Associates that is managing our Monticello, Mississippi LPFM project advised me that the FCC Form 620 has been submitted to the Mississippi State Historic Preservation Office for their review and sign-off. In the meantime, we are still waiting for a response from three of the five Indian tribes that were notified. Two other Indian tribes have already expressed no interest in our matter.

We expect to demonstrate further progress in our next 30-day report. The foregoing statements are true and are made under the penalty of perjury.
