

**Affidavit on Directional Antenna Installation**

On July 19, 2005, I oversaw the installation of the directional antenna system for WXAL-FM. I certify all installation instructions were followed. Due to local zoning requirements forcing changes in tower construction, the center of radiation was lowered from 38m to 34m AGL which is within the 4m limit allowed by 73.1690. All parasitic elements were measured and positioned as specified by Shively Labs. No problems were encountered during the installation. No other antenna of any type is mounted on the same tower level as a directional antenna, and no antenna of any type is mounted within the horizontal or vertical distance specified by the Shively Labs as being necessary for proper directional operation.

I have been a broadcast engineer for 20 years. During that time, I have overseen the installation of many FM antennas, of varying sizes and locations. I have also received instruction at the Shively factory in the correct installation of their directional antennas.
