On August 24, 2009, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter outlining the following interference issue:

Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. W32DF, Hempstead, NY. – BLTTL-20090522AEX

You were given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified interference problem within (30) days from the date of this letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

Our records indicate that no amendment has been filed to resolve the above referenced interference issue, Further our records indicate that the licensee has filed a digital license application to cover the original digital construction permit prior to the above referenced modification and that the licensee has superseded this modification proposal by filing the minor change proposal BPDTL-20090911AAV; therefore, the above referenced application is considered superseded and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
