**Request for Special Temporary Authority**  
**Notice of Operation During Modification of Facilities**  
NCE Station WRUR-FM, Rochester, NY

The University of Rochester Broadcast Corp. (“URBC”), pursuant to Section 73.1615 of the FCC’s rules, notifies the FCC of the operation of noncommercial educational radio Station WRUR-FM, Rochester, New York, with temporary facilities in order to continue operation during the process of modifying the station’s facilities as authorized by a construction permit. URBC also respectfully requests Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to continue its current operation pending the completion and licensing of the station’s modification permit.

URBC applied for a minor change to WRUR-FM’s licensed facility in November, 2006 in FCC File No. BPED-20061117ABO, and the application was granted by the FCC in July, 2007. URBC subsequently filed in FCC File No. BMPED-20070907AAV for a minor modification to the minor change permit, and the modified permit was granted in November, 2008. Both the original minor change application and the later modification of permit specified the same new facility site for WRUR-FM, although the original application provided for a non-directional antenna facility and the later application proposed a directional antenna and higher power.

While URBC is in the process of modifying the WRUR-FM facilities to match the granted directional antenna modification of permit authorization, it seeks STA to cover operation at the new site with a temporary non-directional facility in accordance with the initial minor change permit grant. Notably, the proposed STA operation’s 60 dbu contour lies entirely within the 60 dbu contour of the currently authorized construction permit in File No. BMPED-20070907AAV. See attached Engineering Statement. As the Engineering Statement also explains, the STA operation otherwise matches the current construction permit, except for a lower ERP and the omni-directional antenna.

A grant of STA will serve the public interest because it will allow URBC to maintain its existing noncommercial educational radio broadcasting over WRUR-FM for local listeners in the Rochester area during the modification of the station’s facilities and pending the completion of the station’s currently authorized modifications.

URBC is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates WRUR-FM on a noncommercial educational basis. This application is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1114 of the Commission’s Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules.
