Amended and Restated
Other Media Interests

Transferees Thomas H. Lee Equity Fund VI, L.P. ("THL"), and Bain Capital ("CC") IX, L.P. ("Bain" and, together with THL, the "Transferees"), reported in this application as initially filed that (1) affiliates of THL and Bain held minority attributable interests in Cumulus Media Partners, LLC ("CMP"), and (2) THL and certain of its affiliates (but not Bain) held a minority attributable interest in Broadcast Media Partners, Inc. ("BMPI"), the indirect parent of Univision Communications, Inc. ("Univision"). The Transferees stated their intention to convert each of these interests to non-attributable form such that, as of the closing of their acquisition of Clear Channel Communications, Inc. (1) THL, Bain, and their respective affiliates will not hold any attributable interest in CMP; and (2) THL and its affiliates will not hold any attributable interest in BMPI. On November 19, 2007, THL and Bain amended the instant application to update the Commission on THL's and Bain's efforts to render these interests non-attributable. This Amended and Restated Exhibit 16 further updates the Commission on the present status of these efforts and provides the Commission with an updated list of the Transferees' other media interests as of the date hereof.

THL and Its Affiliates No Longer Hold Any Attributable Interest in Broadcast Media Partners, Inc. or Univision Communications, Inc.

THL and certain affiliated investment funds formerly held an attributable voting stock interest in BMPI. BMPI is the parent corporation of Broadcast Media Partners Holdings, Inc., which, in turn, is the parent corporation of Univision. Univision (through various subsidiaries) controls and has attributable interests in various radio and television station licensees. THL no longer holds an attributable interest in BMPI.¹

On November 16, 2007, Thomas H. Lee Partners, LP filed a Request for Clarification asking that the Commission confirm that the conversion of its interest in BMPI to non-attributable form fully satisfies (or renders moot) the condition in paragraph 47 of the Commission's decision consenting to the transfer of Univision.² The Request for Clarification remains pending.

¹ On October 22, 2007, BMPI notified the Commission that, by virtue of a conversion of voting stock interests to non-voting stock, THL and its affiliates no longer hold any attributable interest in BMPI or Univision. In connection with that stock conversion, THL relinquished its right to designate members of the board of directors of BMPI or of any of its subsidiaries, including Univision; and those members of the board of directors of BMPI and Univision formerly designated by THL have resigned. Accordingly, THL no longer has an attributable interest in BMPI, Univision, or any subsidiary of Univision.

**Applications Are Pending Before the Commission to Convert the
Minority Interests of THL and Bain in CMP to Non-Attributable
Form in Accordance with the Amended CMP Organizational
Documents**

THL affiliate Thomas H. Lee Equity Fund V, L.P., together with other affiliated funds ("THL-V"), hold in the aggregate a 25% attributable interest in CMP by way of a right to appoint two directors to CMP's eight-member governing board. Bain affiliate Bain Capital Partners (SQ) VIII, L.P., together with other affiliated funds ("Bain-SQ"), also hold in the aggregate a 25% attributable interest in CMP by way of Bain-SQ's right to appoint two directors to CMP's eight-member governing board. The other members of CMP are (i) Cumulus Media, Inc., a publicly traded corporation ("CMI"), and (ii) certain affiliates of Blackstone FC Communications Partners, L.P. ("Blackstone").

On October 12, 2007, THL-V and Bain-SQ filed applications (the "CMP Transfer Applications") requesting Commission consent to a transfer of control of CMP that would result from THL-V and Bain-SQ becoming non-attributable and subject to the Commission's "insulation" criteria with regard to their CMP investments. See Public Notice Report No. 26593 (released October 17, 2007) at 12-15, 17-24.

On January 8, 2008, the parties amended the CMP Transfer Applications to reflect the following: (1) the CMP organizational documents have been amended to provide expressly for THL-V and Bain-SQ, subject to Commission grant of the CMP Transfer Applications and consummation of the resulting transfer of control, to become "insulated" (and thus non-attributable) members of CMP in accordance with the Commission's "insulation" criteria; (2) CMI and Blackstone have joined and signed the CMP Transfer Applications as parties thereto; and (3) CMP has caused its licensee subsidiaries to join and sign the CMP Transfer Applications as a party thereto and to certify pursuant to Section 73.3555 Note 2(f), that, subject to and concurrently with the consummation of the transfer of control specified in the CMP Transfer Applications, (a) THL-V and Bain-SQ will become non-attributable members of CMP pursuant to amendments to the organizational documents of CMP which, *inter alia*, incorporate the Commission's criteria for insulated members of limited liability companies and (b) CMP has no actual knowledge that THL-V or Bain-SQ will be materially involved in the management or operation of CMP after their membership interests become non-attributable. The CMP Transfer Applications are pending before the Commission.

CMP through its subsidiaries is the licensee of the following broadcast stations. Upon Commission approval and consummation of the CMP Transfer Applications, the Transferees would no longer have an attributable interest in these stations:
