Third Presbyterian Church of Rockford was founded in October 1910 in Rockford, Illinois. Its mission is to evangelize through proclaiming and teaching the Word. One method it uses is educating its members and others in the community with Bible principles and application. Another method is through involvement in service to its membership and other citizens in the Rockford area community.

An LPFM radio station will allow the Third Presbyterian Church to better achieve its mission through community service, education, training students, and inspiration to its membership and others in the following ways.

Community Service

- Weekly programming covering health-related issues
- Regular programming on spiritual values and concerns
- Ministry and community service to shut-ins
- PSAs and community service bulletins

Education

- Weekly or biweekly programming led by area neighborhood associations
- Fire safety and medical emergency information
- Educational broadcasts in the history and practice of the Christian tradition (including live and recorded worship services)
- Calendar and regular posting of concerns / outreach / other opportunities in the Rockford area

Broadcast Training

- We plan to include local boy and girl scouts in the programming and broadcasting of the radio station

Inspiration

- As spiritual enrichment and as an encouragement and revitalization for the people of the Rockford area, we plan to provide music, religious services, and other related programs.
