Aleluya Christian Broadcasting, Inc., is a Texas not-for-profit corporation controlled by a four-member Board of Trustees. Aleluya Christian Broadcasting, Inc. is affiliated with La Igelsia del Pueblo, a religious and educational institution founded by Pastor Roberto Villarreal, a trustee of Aleluya Christian Broadcasting, Inc. La Igelsia del Pueblo has served the needs of the local Hispanic population for more than 20 years through numerous programs. La Igelsia del Pueblo operates the Pueblo's Royal Christian School, which provides comprehensive primary and secondary education from the pre-kindergarten level through high school graduation.

Aleluya Christian Broadcasting, Inc. exists to promote educational purposes including:

1. To provide religious instruction and moral teaching based on the Bible.
2. To provide programming that is beneficial to the whole family through biblical teachings and inspirational music.
3. To provide the opportunity for and to promote discussion in all areas of family, contemporary social, religious and personal life issues.
4. To assist the members of the local community discover solutions to the personal, social, relational, health and financial problems typical of contemporary society.
5. To teach the ideals of citizenship, integrity, personal responsibility, moral rectitude, and spiritual maturity.
6. Foster unity in the Christian churches.

In accordance with the five general principles enumerated above, the applicant will operate KUZN(FM) in accordance with Section 73.503(a) of the Commission's rules, to advance an educational program, through the transmission of educational, cultural and entertainment programs. Specific examples include:

1. Biblical Teaching Programs: The station will dedicate a substantial amount of time to biblical teaching programs. Program offerings will include "Dios Habla Al Pueblo" with Pastor Roberto Ruben Villarreal, as well as the biblical teaching programs of more than 25 local churches, and thus foster greater understanding of the Bible and its contents, as well as of the commonalities and differences among different Christian denominations.
2. Teaching principles of daily living: The station will air lectures by inspirational guest speakers, local church sponsored services and programs, and inspirational music. Teachers and visiting scholars from the Pueblo's Royal Christian School will be featured guests on the station as well as provide off-air training to local ministers. These program offerings and off-air seminars will also serve to encourage growth in the understanding of the Bible, viewpoints taken from it, and unity among participants.
3. Community open line: The station will provide a forum for listeners to participate in dialogue concerning issues of importance.
4. Inspirational music and moral discussions: The station will provide uplifting music in the Spanish language on a commercial-free basis, and a forum for discussion directed to the unique needs of the local Spanish-speaking community. Additionally, the applicant will seek to serve as a local Spanish-language outlet for quality syndicated programs in the nature of "Focus on the Family," which address specific issues faced by families and young people and attempt to provide solutions which promote strong individual moral values and build strong local communities.
5. News and weather: The station will provide news and weather information throughout the broadcast day.
6. Programs specifically with the Pueblo's Royal Christian School: The station will seek to work with the Pueblo's Royal Christian School to develop youth programs, including internships or volunteer programs that develop skills needed in the broadcast industry, as well as to develop public affairs programming content on the station.
