

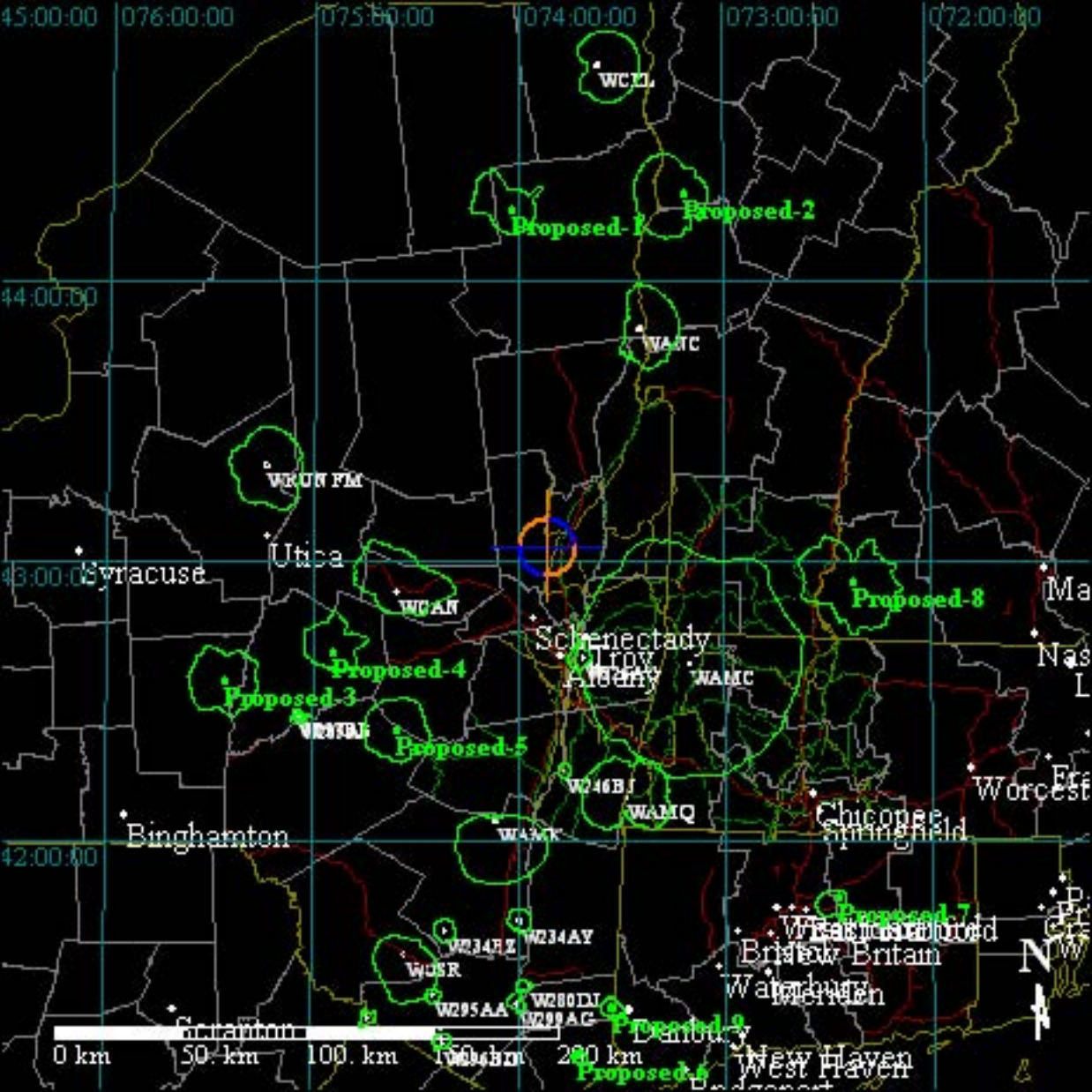

**Diversity of Ownership**

WAMC submits the following documentation in support of its claim for points for diversity of ownership.

WAMC is the licensee of noncommercial radio stations WAMC(AM) and WAMC(FM) in Albany, New York, WAMK(FM), Kingston, New York, WAMQ(FM), Barrington, Massachusetts, WANC(FM), Ticonderoga, New York, WCAN(FM), Canajoharie, New York, WCEL(FM), Plattsburgh, New York, WOSR(FM), Middletown, New York, WRUN(AM), Utica, New York, and WRUN-FM, Remsen, New York, and multiple FM translator stations. WAMC is applying for a new noncommercial educational FM station in Mt. Kisco, New York (the “Proposed Station”) with the instant application.

As shown in Attachment A, the Proposed Station will not overlap the principal community contour of any commercial or noncommercial AM, FM, or FM translator station in which WAMC has an attributable interest. Moreover, WAMC’s governing documents, by way of a board resolution, require that WAMC’s “diversity of ownership” point claims in connection with this or any application be maintained, in accordance with Section 73.7003 (b)(2) of the Commission’s Rules. *See* Attachment B.


Be it resolved,

“In order for an individual to be eligible to serve as a governing board member or officer, that individual must not have (or must pledge to divest) attributable media interests (as defined by FCC Rules) that would cause a conflict with local diversity requirements under Part 73, Subpart K, of the FCC Rules, but only to the extent that local diversity points are claimed by this organization. In the event of a conflict with such local diversity requirements, the organization may, at its discretion, seek an FCC waiver of attribution based on the individual’s recusal from the broadcast-related business of WAMC.”

“WAMC will not otherwise seek consent from the FCC to obtain a broadcast station that would cause a conflict with local diversity requirements under Part 73, Subpart K, of the FCC Rules, but only to the extent that local diversity points are claimed by this organization.”

This resolution takes effect immediately as provided by the Bylaws of WAMC. Copies of this resolution will be placed in official files as required. The foregoing language will also be inserted into the Bylaws of WAMC pending ratification by the full Board of Trustees at its next Annual Meeting.
