PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT

By this application, Telemundo Communications Group, Inc. (“Company”), and TN Acquisition Corp. (“Acquisition Subsidiary”) request Commission consent to the transfer of control of certain television station licensees, each an indirect subsidiary of the Company, from the Company to Acquisition Subsidiary. This amendment reports the sale of four low power television stations and requests inclusion of an additional Commission authorization.

Low Power Television Stations. Exhibits 5 and 7 reported that Telemundo of Northern California License Corporation (“Telemundo California”) holds the licenses for eight low power television stations. Since the filing of this application, Telemundo California has assigned the licenses for the following stations to third parties, pursuant to Commission consent:

- W32AY (now WTMU-LP), Boston, Massachusetts;
- K47DQ, Sacramento, California;
- K52CK, Stockton, California; and
- K61FI, Modesto, California.

Concurrently with the filing of this amendment, Telemundo California is deleting these four low power television stations from the application. *See* FCC File Nos. BTCTTL-20011101ABN-ABQ. Consequently, Exhibits 5 and 7 of the application are hereby amended to delete all references to W32AY, K47DQ, K52CK, and K61FI.

Additional Authorization. As disclosed in Exhibit 5 to the application, the Company holds 100 percent of the issued and outstanding shares of Telemundo Network Interest, Inc., which in turn holds a 67 percent interest in Telemundo Network Group LLC (“Network Co.”), the owner of the Telemundo Spanish-language program network. Network Co. holds a Commission permit issued pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 325(c) authorizing the delivery of Telemundo Network programming to XHAS(TV), Channel 33, Tijuana, Mexico, via satellite. Consequently, Exhibits 5 and 7 of the application are hereby amended to include the Section 325(c) authorization. In addition, the parties hereby respectfully request Commission consent to the transfer of control of Network Co., as the holder of a Section 325(c) authorization, from the Company to Acquisition Subsidiary.
