Re: Translator Station K58BL, Request for Displacement Channel Change

Dear Sir:

Peoples TV Association, Inc., working in conjunction with Spokane Television, Inc., has filed a modification to its K53GG Construction Permit to move the displacement channel to 43. Apple Valley Television, Inc., DBA KVEW-TV, Channel 42 and KVEW-DT, Channel 44 has reviewed this proposal. The proposed new Channel 43 outlet is located some 90 miles from the KVEW transmitter site and has sufficient terrain shielding to protect both analog and digital full power coverage. A directional array at the K58BL site will further minimize any chance for interference.

Apple Valley Broadcasting, Inc. does not object to this application. By doing so, however, we do not relinquish KVEW-TV's interference protection under Parts 73 and 74 of the Commission's rules. We are satisfied that Peoples TV Association, Inc. will resolve any interference issues that occur with this facility change in a timely fashion.
