Dear Mr. Wood:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 18, 2022. WLP requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 8, 2018, to continue ND operation to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters¹. In support of the request, WLP stated that additional time will be needed to complete repairs based upon parts that should arrive later this month.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and WLP may continue to operate ND using tower #2 with a maximum of 1.25 kW (day and night). WLP must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. WLP must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date an FCC Form 302 application was filed to update all operating parameters.

This authority expires on **August 2, 2022**.

¹ WYEL(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 600 kHz with 5 kW (day and night).
