Dear Mr. Bradshaw:

On behalf of WRGG-LP, we would like to thank Noel Richardson and the others from the West Virginia Radio Corporation of the Alleghenies that were involved with our on-off testing that took place on Wednesday, November 1, 2017 at Earl's Market in State Line, Pennsylvania.

Obviously, we have never been involved in these types of “turf wars” and was expecting an adversarial situation. It was quite the opposite. We found all involved to be more than cordial and appreciate their cooperation and understanding throughout the entire process.

The report from the site is very simple: neither station could be heard inside Earl's Market at any time during the monitoring.

Earl's Market is patronized by many people who live in the southern section of Antrim Township. Before translator W229CM went on the air, they were able to receive WRGG-LP's signal, particularly in their cars. Once the translator began broadcasting, that signal interfered with WRGG-LP.

A petition was placed at Earl's Market and people signed who had experienced the interference perhaps in their homes, but more probable, in their cars. That petition was submitted to you and addressed as Earl's Market.

We understand the confusion this has caused and the reason Earl's Market was designated as the test site.

We also understand the WRGG-LP is just that, a low power radio station. We were quite please when we began broadcasting on June 14, 2016 that we could cover the only area we wanted to cover, the Greencastle-Antrim area.

Unfortunately, we are no longer able to do so with a translator that has line of site with our community.

We thank you for allowing us to bring forth our grievance and hope a solution can be developed that benefits both radio signals.
