Dear Licensee:

Commission records show that Hispanic Christian Community Network, Inc. is the licensee of low power television station K60GP at Beaumont, Texas.¹ We have received a complaint that the station has never aired a broadcast signal in Beaumont.

As part of our ongoing investigation of this matter, we require certain information regarding the construction of the station. This information must be supported by affidavit of the licensee or other officer or employee with personal knowledge thereof. We request that the following documents and information be provided within fifteen (15) business days from the date of this letter:

- (1) Was the station constructed at the site specified in the construction permit?
If so, provide documentation establishing the date on which the station operated from the authorized site, such as a copy of any lease agreements for Hispanic's use of the site, agreements regarding construction of the station, and affidavits of persons responsible for the construction and operation of the station at the authorized site.
- (2) If the station was not constructed and operated from the authorized site in accordance with all terms, conditions and obligations set forth in Hispanic's construction permit, identify all persons who took part in the decision to file the license application, and explain the basis for Hispanic's decision to file a license to cover the construction of a facility that was not actually constructed. Also provide any written materials, including correspondence, notes and email messages that pertain to the filing of the license application.

¹ The construction permit for the station was granted on December 6, 2004, with an expiration date of December 6, 2007. Hispanic filed an application for a license to cover the construction on the day the permit was to expire. See File No. BLTTL-20071206AED.

- (3) Provide all dates on which the station broadcast a signal intended to be received by the public, as well as documentation of such service, such as retransmission agreements or other programming agreements

Failure to provide the following information, supported by the affidavit of a person with personal knowledge, may result in revocation proceedings against the station.
