RE: Translator interference from W217BI Cumminsville, OH to WYSO-FM

WYSO is a fulltime FM broadcast station licensed to Antioch College Corporation of Yellow Springs, OH operating on 91.3 MHz channel 217. WYSO recently has undertaken a project to relocate its transmitting site to improve its coverage and reception quality, and has been licensed by the FCC to operate from this new site.

It has come to our attention that your translator W217BI which also operates on 91.3 MHz, will be causing significant interference to WYSO for almost 700,000 persons. Attached please find the engineering study indicating the significant extent of the interference, which has been verified with listening tests.

As you know, translators are required to protect broadcast stations from such interference. You may also be aware that instances such as this will qualify W217BI for displacement to a more suitable frequency. Inasmuch as WYSO's new signal will also be hampering reception for W217BI, it would be to our mutual benefit for Calvary Chapel to voluntarily take advantage of the displacement status and move W217BI to a new frequency.

Please consider this solution. I request the favor of a reply.
