**Existence of Applicant**

The applicant, a non-profit charitable, religious and educational organization, is a non-profit corporation which was incorporated by the Kansas Secretary of State on June 9, 2005 and has been in continuous existence and operation since. The applicant provides funding for Catholic education in Beloit, Kansas, which was founded with 15 students in 1879. St. John the Baptist School actually is two schools: an elementary school located at 712 East Main Street in Beloit Kansas, and a middle/high school located at 209 South Cherry Street in Beloit, Kansas. These two locations are within two city blocks of each other, and within two blocks of our headquarters at 622 Main Street, Beloit, Kansas.

The proposed transmitter and antenna location for our proposed low power FM will be on our property next to our headquarters at 622 Main Street, Beloit, Kansas at NAD27 coordinates 39° 27' 30" north latitude and 98° 6' 7" west longitude

As we understand Section 73.853 of the FCC's Rules and Regulations, since the applicant's headquarters have been located within 20 miles of the proposed antenna location for more than the past two years, the applicant qualifies as an "established local applicant" for purposes of the so-called point system. Additionally, all of the members of our governing board have resided within 20 miles of the proposed antenna location for more than the past two years.


**Localism**

As noted above, our organization has had a non-profit corporate existence in the state of Kansas since 2005; at all times it has been in existence within 20 miles of the proposed transmitter and antenna site. In fact, the proposed transmitter site is next to the applicant's physical facilities, 622 Main Street in Beloit, Kansas.

Therefore, this application qualifies as an "established local applicant" pursuant to Section 73.853(b) of the FCC's Rules.
