TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Family Life Educational Foundation (“FLEF”), licensee of FM translator station K212FX, Channel 212D, Shreveport, Louisiana. FLEF has a construction permit to make minor changes in the K212FX facilities by changing to Channel 214D (BPFT-20111222AYH). As a result of the channel change, the call sign of the translator becomes K214BE, which will be used throughout this application. This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for FM translator K214BE.¹ It is further noted that the programming feed method for K214BE should be changed from “Off-Air” to “Other”.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the K214BE permit. The first condition states that FLEF will reduce the power of K214BE or cease operation to insure persons with access to the site are not exposed to radio frequency radiation levels above the limits. FLEF states that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of K214BE or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC’s guidelines.

1) The antenna system is mounted within 2.0 meters above and 4.0 meters below the authorized center of radiation.

The second and final condition states that an application on FCC Form 350 will be submitted prior to commencing program test with the facilities authorized in the underlying permit. This instant application satisfies this condition. Based on the foregoing, it is believed that FLEF has complied with all conditions and can operate K214BE in accordance with Commission rules.
