**I. Clerk's Action**

Issuance of Letters Testamentary to Charlene Casey upon filing of an oath.

**II. Findings**

~~The Petition for Probate of Will of Kenneth Casey (the "Decedent") has been~~  
presented on behalf of Charlene Casey. The court finds:

1. The Decedent died on September 12, 2010, was a resident of  
King County, Washington, and left an estate subject to the jurisdiction of this court.

1           2.     The Decedent's Last Will dated August 31, 2005 ("Will") and the  
2 First Codicil to the Will dated September 2, 2010 (Codicil) were executed in  
3 accordance with RCW11.12.020 by the Decedent, who had attained the age of majority  
4 and was of sound mind.

5           3.     The Will provides that the Personal Representative to be  
6 appointed shall act without bond and with nonintervention powers.

7           4.     Kenneth Casey is deceased and the Decedent left his spouse,  
8 Charlene Casey, surviving. Charlene Casey is qualified and willing to act as Personal  
9 Representative and resides in the State of Washington.

11          5.     The assets of the estate will exceed the expenses, debts, taxes  
12 and claims of creditors, and the estate is fully solvent.

13          6.     In accordance with RCW11.68.011 et seq., the estate is entitled  
14 to be administered without court intervention.

15          7.     All legally required notices, if any, have been given.

16                   **III. Order**

17           Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby ORDERED:

18           1.     That the certificate of the witnesses attached to the Will of the  
19 Decedent reduced to writing and signed by them as witnesses is the testimony in  
20 support of the Will in accordance with RCW11.20.020(2).

21           2.     That the proffered Will and Codicil are established as the Last  
22 Will & Testament of the Decedent and are admitted to probate.

3. That Charlene Casey is appointed as Personal Representative of the estate, to act without bond.

4. That the Clerk of the Court shall issue Letters Testamentary to Charlene Casey upon filing of an oath as required by law.

5. That the estate is fully solvent.

6. That the Personal Representatives is entitled to administer and close the Decedent's estate without further court intervention or supervision.
