TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Radio Training Network, Inc. ("RTN"), an applicant seeking authority to construct a new FM station on Channel 218C3 at Sebring, Florida (BPED-19960307ME). RTN has entered into a settlement agreement with the applicant for a mutually exclusive application to resolve the conflict between the two applications. RTN amends its pending application to provide contour protection to the application of American Educational Broadcasting at Clewiston, Florida (BPED-19960822MA). Further, the application, BPED-19960820MB, filed by Moody Bible Institute is to be withdrawn. RTN herein proposes to amend its application by relocating the facility, increasing the effective radiated power to 20.5 kilowatts (circularly polarized) and installing a directional antenna system.

RTN is proposing to locate its proposed new FM facility on an existing tower. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration has not been apprised of this proposal. The tower has been registered with the Commission and assigned Antenna Structure Registration #1054833. All exhibits called for on FCC Form 340, Section VII, are attached hereto, including an analysis of the proposed facilities in comparison to all other potentially impacted non-commercial stations on co- and adjacent channels (see Exhibit A).

Further, the proposed facility is within the reference distance to VHF television station WKMG-TV, Channel 6, Orlando, Florida. See Exhibit B for §73.525 compliance. All other exhibits used to certify the information contained in the application have been forwarded to RTN and are available for submission to the Commission upon request.
