Dear Applicants:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned, contingently related minor change applications. In application BPED-20071114AGT, Michigan Community Radio ("MCR"), licensee of noncommercial educational ("NCE") FM station WSFP(FM),<sup>1</sup> proposes to change the licensed facilities of WSFP(FM) from Channel 203A at Rust Township, Michigan, to Channel 201C3 at Harrisville, Michigan. In application BMPED-20071115AAA, Northland Community Broadcasters ("NCB"), licensee of NCE FM station WJOJ(FM)<sup>2</sup> proposes to change the licensed facilities of WJOJ(FM) from Channel 209C2 at Harrisville, Michigan, to Channel 209C2 at Rust Township, Michigan. For the reasons set forth below, we dismiss the contingently related WSFP(FM) and WJOJ(FM) minor change applications.

Our engineering review of MCR application BPED-20071114AGT reveals that the proposed facility fails to comply with Section 73.3573(g)(2) of the Commission's Rules.<sup>3</sup> Pursuant to this section, the facilities specified by the applicant at the proposed community of license must be mutually exclusive,

as defined in Section 73.509,<sup>4</sup> with the applicant's current facilities. In this instance, in order to be mutually exclusive, the WFSP(FM) proposed protected 60 dBμ F(50,50) contour must overlap the WSFP(FM) licensed interfering 100 dBμ F(50,10) contour of the licensed facility. Alternatively, the WSFP(FM) licensed protected 60 dBμ F(50,50) contour must overlap the WSFP(FM) proposed interfering 100 dBμ F(50,10) contour. In either case, the proposed WSFP(FM) contours do not overlap the corresponding licensed WSFP(FM) contours. Thus, the proposed WSFP(FM) facilities on Channel 201C3 at Harrisville, Michigan, are not mutually exclusive with the licensed WSFP(FM) facilities on Channel 203A at Rust Township, Michigan, and the proposal violates Section 73.3573(g)(2) of the Commission's Rules.<sup>5</sup>

In light of the above, MCR application BPED-20071114AGT is unacceptable for filing pursuant to Section 73.3566(a) of the Commission's Rules<sup>6</sup> and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. Pursuant to Section 73.3517(e) of the Commission's Rules,<sup>7</sup> dismissal of any application that is part of a group of contingently related applications as unacceptable will result in the dismissal of all the related applications. Therefore, contingently related NCB application BMPED-20071115AAA IS HEREBY DISMISSED. These actions are taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.<sup>8</sup>
