AGREEMENT FOR TRANSFER OF STATION

This application is one of two applications filed concurrently for the Commission's consent to the transfers of control of (i) Desert Television LLC ("Desert"), the licensee of Class A low power television station KPSP-CD, Cathedral City, California and (ii) U-Dub Productions LLC ("U-Dub"), the licensee of low power television station KYAV-LP, Palm Springs, California, from JLH Holdings LLC ("Holdings") to James Ralph Houston II.¹

Holdings is the sole member of Desert and U-Dub. The sole member of Holdings is the JLH Living Trust. At the time that Desert acquired KPSP-CD in 2001 and U-Dub acquired KYAV-LP in 2006, Jacqueline L. Houston, a U.S. citizen, was the sole member of each company. In September 2007, solely for tax and estate planning purposes, all of Ms. Houston's assets, including her membership interests in Desert and U-Dub, were transferred to the JLH Living Trust; and Holdings was established as an intermediate holding company for the Trust's membership interests in Desert and U-Dub. Pursuant to the trust agreement, and prior to her death on September 14, 2011, Ms. Houston was the sole beneficiary of the JLH Living Trust, and her husband, James R. Houston, a Canadian citizen, was the Trust's sole trustee.² As the sole beneficiary of the JLH Living Trust, Ms. Houston had the right at any time, in her sole discretion, to remove any asset from the Trust, including her interests in stations KPSP-CD and KYAV-LP, and reassume actual as well as beneficial ownership of such asset, thus evidencing her ultimate control over all of the Trust's assets. Indeed, despite the Trust's formal legal ownership of her interests in Desert and U-Dub, Ms. Houston remained in operational control of the stations at all times prior to her death. Mr. Houston did not take any actions with respect to the stations independent of his wife, and Ms. Houston continued to exercise ultimate control of the stations during the remainder of her life, the Trust notwithstanding. As a result, the stations' local management employees perceived Ms. Houston as the controlling owner of the stations, a perception reinforced by the fact that Ms. Houston had her own reserved parking space at the stations' main studios (and Mr. Houston did not).³

² Upon Ms. Houston's death on September 14, 2011, by operation of the trust agreement, Mr. Houston and the Dorsey & Whitney Trust Company LLC became co-trustees of the JLH Living Trust. Mr. Houston is actively seeking his U.S. citizenship, and expects to become a U.S. citizen within the next few months.

³ In this regard, it is noted that Ms. Houston's dominant role in the stations' affairs was so pervasive that the Form 323 biennial ownership reports for Desert and U-Dub submitted on December 17, 2009, erroneously reported Ms. Houston as the sole member of Holdings.

In establishing the Trust back in 2007, the licensees did not appreciate the significance of this action for FCC purposes. Instead, given the fact that Ms. Houston's involvement with and control over the stations did not change with the establishment of the Trust, the Houstons assumed they were simply effectuating a tax and estate planning arrangement of no consequence beyond their own personal affairs.

Following Ms. Houston's death, FCC counsel became aware of the existence of the Trust and Mr. Houston's Canadian citizenship, and, upon advising the parties of the regulatory implications of this situation, Desert, U-Dub and Holdings moved quickly to resolve the matter. Specifically, to remedy the situation, as set forth in the Sale and Purchase Agreement attached hereto, the FCC's consent is respectfully requested to allow Holdings to transfer all of the membership units in both Desert and U-Dub to James Ralph Houston II. James Ralph Houston II is the son of James R. Houston and Jacqueline L. Houston, and is a U.S. citizen.
