

NATURE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES OF ASSIGNEE

Non-Profit and Educational Nature

It is the intent of the assignee, to operate the proposed station in a manner consistent of Subpart G of Part 73 of the Commission's Rules. The assignor is a local church which is a non-profit charitable, religious and educational corporation in the State of West Virginia. The assignee operates as a non-profit charitable, religious and educational, local trustee association in the State of Ohio.

According to its by-laws the Marietta-Williamstown Education Association was "organized for the sole purpose of charitable, educational, religious, didactic or instructive purposes". In *Columbia Bible College Broadcasting Co.*, 6 FCC Rcd 516 (1991), at paragraphs 9 and 10, the Commission stated that religiously-oriented applicants can meet the eligibility standards set forth in Section 73.503 of the Commission's Rules, where the applicant (1) proposes an overall educational program and (2) its proposed programming furthers its educational objectives. As can be seen by this Exhibit, the applicant is religiously oriented, was formed to be an "educational" entity, and proposes to operate an overall educational program which is non-commercial. Furtherance of Educational Objectives

The applicant is eligible pursuant to Section 73.503 to be a non-commercial licensee of the station covered by this application, because the applicant proposes programming which constitutes an overall educational program and the programming furthers the organization's educational objectives. In this case, the applicant intends to broadcast programs to further its educational purposes as outlined above.

WVVP-LP will be operated with community oriented, local non-denominational, educational and inspirational programming. Examples of educational programs to be carried on WVVP-LP are:

1. "Mid-Ohio Mornings". This local program would be presented each Monday through Friday at 6:00 to 9:00 AM hosted by Doug Hannah and features unique and cultural religious music intermixed with readings from various theologians as well as offering community events updates and highlights from local community organizations.
2. "In Touch". This program would be presented each Monday through Friday at 9:00 to 10 AM and hosted by Dr. Charles Stanley. The program discusses and teaches on matters theology and practical religion.
3. "Turning Point". This program would be presented each Monday through Friday at 10 to 10:30 AM hosted by Dr. David Jeremiah. This program teaches on matters of theology and apologetics.
4. "Grace to You". This program would be presented each Monday through Friday at 10 to 10:30 AM hosted by Dr. John MacArthur. This program teaches on matters of theology and apologetics.
5. "Watchman on the Wall". This program would be presented each Monday through Friday at 2 to 3 PM with various hosts and is a call-in and interview talk show with various guests that deals with apologetics, practical advice for families and matters of theology.
6. "The Word for Life". This program would be presented Monday through Friday at 6 PM sharing local theologically trained religious teachers with at minimum graduate level education from within the listening area of WVVP-LP.
7. "Bluegrass Gospel Hour". This local program will be presented on Saturdays at 2 PM and Sundays at 10 PM presenting the historic and cultural aspects of bluegrass music and its historic confluence on religious music.
8. "American Gospel". This local program will be presented Sundays from 1 to 4 PM and hosted by Christopher Truman presenting and features historically distinctive and educational religious music intermixed with readings from various theologians and historians as well offering community events updates from local community organizations as well as interviews of religious and community leaders from within the WVVP listening area.

The proposed low power FM station will also work with local churches and community organizations to assist their educational efforts.
