Dear Counsel:

This letter concerns the request, filed February 13, 2004, and amended April 6, 2004, on behalf of Greece Central School District ("GCSD") for special temporary authority to permit FM Translator W286AE to remain silent.

Your request states that GCSD suspended the translator's operations on February 10, 2004 because of financial considerations. Specifically, you note that full service station WGMC(FM) now serves the listeners W286AE originally intended to serve. As a result, GCSD is evaluating whether it should assign the translator's license and/or sell the station's equipment.

Your request will be granted. Accordingly, special temporary authority is granted to permit FM Translator W286AE to remain silent through February 10, 2005. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for W286AE will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 A.M., February 11, 2005.**¹ See Pub.
