On April 16, 2009, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter outlining the following interference issue:

Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. New, Atlanta, GA. – BDCCDTL-20081215ACT

You were given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified interference problem within (30) days from the date of that letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.
