KRCR-TV, Redding, California (the “Station”) respectfully submits this request for extension of the Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) authorized in FCC File No. BDSTA-20090717ABB. The STA authorizes the Station to operate with an effective radiated power (“ERP”) of 25.2 kW.

The Station originally sought to operate with this ERP because, following its transition to final digital operations on VHF channel 7, it received approximately 1,200 calls and 120 e-mails from over-the-air viewers who had previously been able to receive the Station’s pre-transition digital signal (on UHF channel 34) but were no longer able to receive the signal. Since the Station increased its power to 25.2 kW, pursuant to the STA, its viewers have experienced significantly improved reception. Indeed, following the power increase, the Station has received only about 20 calls from viewers experiencing difficulty in receiving the Station’s digital signal. Station personnel also have reached out to many of the viewers who contacted the Station immediately after its transition to final operations on VHF channel 7, and have confirmed that the power increase appears to have resolved the reception problem for the vast majority of these viewers.

Consistent with the terms upon which the FCC granted the original STA, and in support of its extension request, the Station hereby submits a report detailing field strength measurements taken before and after the requested power increase was implemented. This report shows that the power increase appears to have substantially resolved the reception problems previously identified and that extension of the STA would serve the public interest.
