**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Central Florida Educational Foundation, Inc. ("CFEF"), permittee of FM translator station W274AX, Channel 274D, Groveland, Florida. This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Attached, as Exhibit A, is a calculation of the transmitter power output power for the W274AX translator. An ERI FM-100-2-HW, 2 bay half wavelength spaced, antenna was used in lieu of the originally proposed antenna system.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W274AX permit. The first condition notes that an application for station license must be on file before commencing program test with the facilities authorized in the permit. CFEF acknowledges this condition and notes that it will not commence program test until FCC Form 350 is filed with the Commission.

The second condition relates to radio frequency radiation limits at the site. CFEF herein restates that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of W274AX or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that all conditions on the W274AX permit have been satisfied.
