Dear Mr. Schober:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 27, 2017. WRB requests an extension of the STA granted on September 30, 2016, to operate ND temporarily at night from the daytime site pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application to propose a permanent nighttime facility (due to loss of the nighttime site).¹ In support of the request, WRB states that additional time is needed to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


¹ WXVA(AM) is licensed for operation on 610 kHz with 0.38 kW ND (existing daytime site) and 0.5 kW DA (old nighttime site).

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and WRB may continue to operate at night with a maximum of 0.125 kW using the existing daytime site WXVA tower.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. WRB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. WRB must file the required 301 application to show that substantial progress has been made.

This authority expires on **December 23, 2017**.
