Dear Mr. Jacobs:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 24, 2014. RVC requests an extension of the STA originally granted on March 22, 2013, to operate station KCKN(AM) with reduced power using an auxiliary transmitter due to problems with the 50 kW main transmitter.¹ In support of the request, RVC states that additional time is needed to resolve antenna system problems.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

We note that RVC has now been operating with reduced power since November 16, 2012, due to multiple problems, and has been unable to complete all required repairs in order to resume licensed augmented pattern operations since that date. As a result, based upon the repairs already completed and the additional antenna system repairs that are needed, an FCC Form 302 application must be filed with a day and night partial proof (or method of moments proofs)


¹ KCKN(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1020 kHz with 50 kW (day and night).

before the expiration date shown below to verify the return to licensed operations (since RVC now estimates all repairs can be completed within the next 90 days).

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KCKN(AM) may continue to operate during day and night hours with a reduced power of 1 kW. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RVC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² RVC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 13, 2015**.
