Dear Mr. Doyle and Mr. Pai,

Application BP20141110AAS proposes cancelling WZRK 1550 licensed to Lake Geneva, WI (FCC Facility ID 61389) to accommodate a modification of WGLB 1560 licensed to Elm Grove, WI (FCC Facility ID 70350).

While awaiting a response to my purchase offer of WZRK, from its previous owner, I learned of the application to transfer ownership to Joel Kinlow. I met with Mr. Kinlow and made him aware of my interest in owning WZRK. I suggested that he could accomplish his desired signal coverage increase for WGLB, maintain Walworth County's sole AM first service, and receive financial compensation for assets that otherwise become a costly removal liability, as the towers and ground system are located in a flood plain.

I further explained that WZRK should be able to remain a licensed facility, operating at a reduced power and not interfere with the intent of the BP20141110AAS proposal.

My reason for writing is not to squelch the improvement of WGLB, but to preserve AM service in the community where I reside. While AM station Special Temporary Authority requests and license forfeitures proliferate, I seek the converse.
