This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Radio License Holding CBC, LLC (“RLH”), licensee of AM station WARM, 590 kHz, Scranton, Pennsylvania. RLH herein requests Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to operate WARM with parameters at variance with its license and with reduced power from its authorized location. The station’s lighting system and antenna monitor has been damaged due to lightning. The system monitoring points will be maintained within licensed limits. Repairs of the system, including replacement of Austin Ring type lighting isolation, will be conducted in a timely manner, dependent upon availability of the components and antenna monitor manufacturer timetables.


