## INTERFERENCE ACCEPTANCE AGREEMENT

This Interference Acceptance Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of October 17, 2008 by and between Northeastern Educational Television of Ohio, Inc. ("Northeastern") and Post-Newsweek Stations, Michigan, Inc. ("Post-Newsweek").

- 1. Northeastern is the licensee of television station WNEO-DT, FCC Facility ID No. 49439, Alliance, Ohio, and holds a construction permit issued by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") authorizing it to construct a post-transition digital television ("DTV") facility on Channel 45 (see FCC File No. BPEDT-20080317AGT (the "WNEO Permit")).
- 2. Post-Newsweek is the licensee of television station WDIV-DT, FCC Facility ID No. 53114, Detroit, Michigan, and holds a license issued by the FCC authorizing it to operate a post-transition DTV facility on Channel 45 (see FCC File No. BLCDT-19990429KX (the "WDIV License")).
- 3. Northeastern desires to modify the authorized post-transition DTV facilities for WNEO-DT in order to maximize service to the public. Northeastern has filed an application to modify the WNEO Permit in order to construct DTV facilities that transmit at a higher power level than the power level currently authorized by the WNEO Permit. See File No. BMPEDT-20080619AIA ("the WNEO Application").
- 4. Post-Newsweek desires to modify the authorized post-transition DTV facilities for WDIV-DT in order to maximize service to the public. Post-Newsweek has filed an application to construct DTV facilities that transmit at a higher power level than the power level currently authorized by the WDIV License. *See* File No. BPCDT-20080620AFZ (the "WDIV Application").
- 5. The facility proposed by the WDIV Application is predicted cause unique new interference to 1.8325% of the total population predicted to be served by the facility proposed by the WNEO Application. Northeastern hereby acknowledges and agrees to accept such interference.
- 6. As consideration for Northeastern's agreement, Post-Newsweek, for and on behalf of itself and all successor holders of the WDIV License, hereby consents to any future application by Northeastern to modify the WNEO-DT, Alliance, Ohio, facility (the "Subsequent Modification") so long as the unique new interference that would be predicted to be caused by the Subsequent Modification would be no more than 1.8325% of the population served by WDIV-DT. Post-Newsweek, for and on behalf of itself and all successor holders of the WDIV License, also agrees that, at the time of an application by Northeastern for such Subsequent Modification, upon request by Northeastern, it will provide such additional reasonable documentation of its consent as the FCC may require.
- 7. For the purposes of this Agreement, "unique new interference" refers to interference in excess of the interference that is predicted to be caused by the interfering station's DTV Table of Allotments Appendix B facility parameters as specified in Memorandum Opinion and Order on Reconsideration of the Seventh Report and Order and Eighth Report and Order, FCC 08-72 (released March 6, 2008), using FCC OET-69 methodology in effect as of the date of this Agreement, assuming a cell size of 2 sq. km and a terrain interval of 1 km. In the event of a Subsequent Modification by Northeastern, even if the FCC has changed the methodology for calculating interference in similar circumstances, the percentage of unique new interference from WNEO-DT to WDIV-DT that is consented to by Post-Newsweek in this Agreement shall be calculated pursuant to the methodology specified above.

Aside from the agreements reflected in paragraphs 5 and 6 of this Agreement, no other consideration has been received or promised by or to either Northeastern or Post-Newsweek in connection with this Agreement.
