Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to the request filed December 22, 2014, on behalf of Kelly Broadcasting System Corporation ("KBS"). KBS requests an extension of the July 1, 2014 special temporary authority ("STA") to operate Station WNIK-FM with reduced power.¹ In support of the request, KBS states that the station's transmitter controller continues to have intermittent problems. The STA is requested to allow reduced power operation as needed until the matter can be resolved.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

¹ WNIK-FM is licensed for operation on Channel 293B1 (106.5 MHz) with effective radiated power of 25 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 6 meters.

In view of the above, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WNIK-FM may continue to operate with reduced power as needed, until repair work on the transmitter can be completed. KBS must notify the Commission when the STA is no longer required. KBS must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 19, 2015**.
