Dear Sir:

This is to inform you that Weigel Broadcasting Co. ("Weigel"), licensee of Station WMYS-LD, South Bend, Indiana, has consented and does consent to the interference to the facilities of WMYS-LD that would be caused by the facilities for your Station WWME-CA, Chicago, Illinois, that are proposed in your application BPTTA-20081023AAZ.

As you know, Weigel is both the sole owner of WMYS-LD and also the primary equity owner of Channel 23 Limited Partnership and its station WWME-CA, and the two stations are also under common control.
