

Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authorization

Radio License Holding SRC LLC (“RLH”), pursuant to Section 73.1635 of the FCC’s rules, hereby requests that the initial temporary authorization (“STA”) for radio station KTCT(AM), San Mateo, California (File No. BSTA-19990309WX, as extended, *inter alia*, by File No. BESTA-20150227ACA), be extended for an additional 180 days.

The station’s most recent STA was granted by the Commission on March 16, 2015 and is scheduled to expire on September 16, 2015. As stated in RLH’s most recent extension request filed February 27, 2015 (File No. BESTA-20150227ACA), the STA is necessary to enable KTCT to overcome interference caused by the unauthorized operation of co-channel station KXED, Mexicali, Baja California, Mexico. KTCT therefore has been authorized to continue operating with its daytime facilities during nighttime hours in order to overcome interference from station KXED. The interference situation with respect to the co-channel Mexican station has not changed. The conditions which led the Commission to grant the initial STA (File No. BSTA-19990309WX), as subsequently extended and revised, remain the same. Accordingly, RLH respectfully submits that a further extension of the STA is warranted and hereby requests a further STA for a period of 180 days.
