Dear Mr. Rowe:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 31, 2022. TMB requests a further extension of the STA granted on July 2, 2020, to continue operating from an alternate site with a long wire antenna to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, TMB stated that it plans to file the application shortly to propose a new ND antenna system at the site coordinates shown below.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TMB may continue to operate with the following facilities:
