NYTC publishes *The New York Times*, a daily newspaper in New York City, the same market as the radio stations. This radio-newspaper cross-ownership is grandfathered pursuant to Section 73.3555, Note 4 of the rules. None of NYTC’s other newspaper interests is located in areas within the purview of the FCC’s cross-ownership rules.

The parties to the application (see Transferee Exhibit 14) do not have attributable media interests apart from those of NYTC. As reflected in Exhibit 14, a 1997 Trust is the single majority shareholder of NYTC (*see* Section 73.3615(a)(3)(i)(C)) and, thus, no minority voting stock interest in NYTC is cognizable.
