**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of J. L. Brewer Broadcasting, LLC ("JLB"), licensee of FM translator station W227AK, Channel 227D, Chattanooga, Tennessee. JLB seeks to make minor changes in the facilities of W227AK by increasing the effective radiated power and utilizing a directional antenna. The W227AK facility will continue to operate as a fill-in translator for station WMPZ, Channel 229A, Ringgold, Georgia. As indicated on Exhibit A, the proposed W227AK translator's 60 dBu contour is within the authorized 60 dBu contour of WMPZ.

The proposed W227AK facility will be implemented at the station's existing transmitter site. Therefore, the Federal Aviation Administration was not apprised of this proposal. The tower on which the antenna is to be installed has been registered with the FCC and assigned Antenna Structure Registration Number 1224785. Attached as Exhibit B is a study demonstrating that the proposed W2277AK translator will not cause interference to any full service station, nor will interference be delivered to or received from any existing FM translator station or LPFM facility.

All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 349 has been forwarded to JLB and is available to the Commission upon request.
