The previous STA BSTA-20180718ABD (as extended) expired January 24, 2021. As an STA extension request, this filing -- filed more than six months after the previous STA expired -- is untimely and subject to dismissal without consideration. However, we will treat this filing as a new request for STA and process accordingly. This new STA does not cover any unauthorized operation that occurred between January 25, 2021 and August 5, 2021.

Special Temporary Authority IS GRANTED for operation of the station above with the parameters specified in the STA request only. The licensee is responsible for addressing any complaints of interference that may arise.

This new STA authority expires **March 1, 2022**. Please be sure to file any STA extension request on or before the expiration date of the current STA.

Considerations:

Licensee must take all steps to ensure that workers and the public are not exposed to radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure limit.

This Special Temporary Authority does not supersede any non-FCC-regulated requirements applicable to the STA-authorized facility. The licensee remains solely and wholly responsible for maintaining compliance with such requirements.

Requests for extension of STA may be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.
