

Statement of Educational Objectives

Horizon Christian Fellowship is a non-stock, non-profit corporation chartered under the laws of the State of Indiana, and is tax-exempt pursuant to Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Horizon Christian Fellowship operates a church and a Christian School system in Indianapolis, Indiana. With an accredited pre-K program, an elementary school and accredited junior and senior high school programs, Horizon Christian Fellowship educates approximately 310 students using a standard academic curriculum supplemented with moral and religious teaching. In addition to providing standard classroom education and religious teaching to school-age children and college students, Horizon Christian Fellowship's educational and moral teachings address adult social problems such as divorce, mental illness, child abuse, teen pregnancy, alcoholism and drug abuse.

Horizon Christian Fellowship's objective in acquiring radio stations is to teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and thereby spread redemption, hope and social progress in the areas outlined above. Radio stations will expand the reach of our educational programs, particularly those geared to adults within the service areas.

Using radio will permit Horizon Christian Fellowship to advance its objectives by putting to work its considerable educational talents and capabilities to address moral and religious subjects outside the standard classroom setting, and otherwise on a far broader scale.

It will be our policy to provide the highest quality programming, stressing spiritual and moral values. Programs and messages will be responsive to the problems, needs and interests of the community of license

and service area. Our programming will be in good taste and suitable for listeners of all ages. All programming will help fulfill our educational objectives, and radio station operations will be conducted on a non-commercial basis.
