

Hoak Media of Wichita Falls, L.P. (“Hoak Wichita Falls”), the proposed assignee, hereby certifies that the proposed assignment complies with the multiple ownership rules and cross-media ownership limits of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”).

The station proposed to be acquired in the transaction is full-power commercial television station KAUZ-TV, Wichita Falls, Texas, which is assigned to the Wichita Falls, TX-Lawton, OK Nielsen Designated Market Area (“DMA”). Neither Hoak Wichita Falls nor any party with an attributable interest in Hoak Wichita Falls currently holds any broadcast authorizations or other media interests other than the station proposed to be acquired in the instant transaction. However, an application is pending to assign the licenses and assets of full-power commercial television station KREX-TV, Grand Junction, Colorado, satellite television station KREY-TV, Montrose, Colorado, and satellite television station KREG-TV, Glenwood Springs, Colorado, all assigned to the Grand Junction-Montrose DMA, to Hoak Media of Colorado, LLC (“Hoak Colorado”), which is 100% owned by Hoak Media, LLC (“Hoak”), the ultimate parent of Hoak Wichita Falls.¹

Following consummation of the instant transaction and the proposed Colorado transaction, Hoak will control television stations in two markets and will not hold any media interests other than the television stations identified above. Accordingly, Hoak is in compliance with Section 73.3555 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 73.3555, and the national television ownership and cross-media ownership limits set forth in the Commission’s *Report and Order* in MB Dockets 02-277 and 03-130 and MM Dockets 00-244, 01-235 and 01-317, FCC 03-127 (rel. July 2, 2003) (“Biennial Review Order”). Because Hoak will own and control only one television station in the Wichita Falls, TX-Lawton, OK DMA after consummation of the instant transaction, Hoak also is in compliance with the Commission’s local television ownership rule, 47 C.F.R. § 73.3555, and the local television ownership limits set forth in the Biennial Review Order
