

This is in reference to licensee letter dated 3/31/95. Effective 4/14/95. Authority and terms in special temporary authority granted 10/16/89 reinstated and extended through 11/15/95. Special temporary authority is hereby granted to operate with increase power levels set to exceed 9.9 kilowatts daytime and 4.7 kilowatts nighttime for the purpose of negating the effects of interference received from Cuban operation in Havana. Operating patterns should comply with those submitted in August 8, 1989, daytime request and September 19, 1989, nighttime request and full directional and nondirectional proofs to be conducted for the proposed day and night operations and submitted to this office for approval before this authority can be implemented. Monitor points to be established:

This authority is subject to termination upon reduction of power or cessation of operation by Cuban operation or upon Commission instruction to WWCL at which time WWCL must return to the presently licensed operating specifications.
