MIDWAY BROADCASTING CORPORATION - EXHIBIT 1

**REQUEST FOR TERMINATION OF SHARE TIME STATUS
AND
REQUEST FOR FULL TIME AUTHORITY**

Midway Broadcasting Corporation ("Midway") hereby requests that its license authorization be modified to fulltime operation. Attached as Attachment A is a copy of the WRL(AM) license authorization which shows that the licensee is authorized to share time with Migala Enterprises ("Migala"), licensee of WCEV(AM).

On October 7, 2020, the Media Bureau granted Migala an extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit WCEV to remain silent. (Attachment B). In the STA extension letter, the Bureau stated:

Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WCEV(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., January 21, 2021. (emphasis in original)

WCEV has not resumed broadcasting at any time during the preceding 12-month period, and, therefore, its license expired automatically at 12:01 a.m., January 21, 2021. In support of this fact, Midway submits the attached photographs (Attachment C), which show the transmitter building where the WCEV transmitter was previously housed. The transmitter and all related transmission facilities have been removed. Thus, it is clear that Migala has abandoned the license.

Midway therefore requests that its license be immediately modified to permit fulltime operation.

In support of its request for expedited action, Midway advises the Commission that Midway is now obligated to incur the full cost of certain expenses that were previously shared with Migala. As a result of Migala's abandonment of its license, Midway was required to pay Migala's share of these expenses in 2020, and will be required to pay Migala's share in 2021 and going forward:

1. 100-year land lease
2. Real estate taxes
3. Tower maintenance
4. Utilities
5. Insurance
6. Transmitter site maintenance

Midway requests expedited action on this request so that it can take advantage of the fulltime operating hours to increase revenues to cover the increased operating costs that Midway must cover because of Migala's abandonment of its license.

STANDARD BROADCAST STATION LICENSE

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ¹the LICENSEE

MIDWAY BROADCASTING CORPORATION

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term ending 3 a.m. Local Time December 1, 1982

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

10. Conditions: SEE PAGE 1a.

GROUND SYSTEM: 120 evenly spaced buried radials 170' to 300' long of 1" x .025" copper ribbon interspersed with 120 similar radials 75' long bonded to a 72' square copper mesh ground screen.

The Commission reserves the right during said license period of terminating this license or making effective any changes or modification of this license which may be necessary to comply with any decision of the Commission rendered as a result of any hearing held under the rules of the Commission prior to the commencement of this license period or any decision rendered as a result of any such hearing which has been designated but not held, prior to the commencement of this license period.

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. Migala:

This letter concerns the request you filed on August 17, 2020, on behalf of Migala Communications Corporation (MCC), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station WCEV to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that MCC stated that Station WCEV(AM) went silent on January 20, 2020, for financial reasons. The previous STA was granted on February 26, 2020, and expired on August 24, 2020. MCC requests extension of its STA for continuing financial reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

MCC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WCEV(AM) to remain silent until January 20, 2021. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WCEV(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., January 21, 2021.**¹

MCC is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If MCC does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³

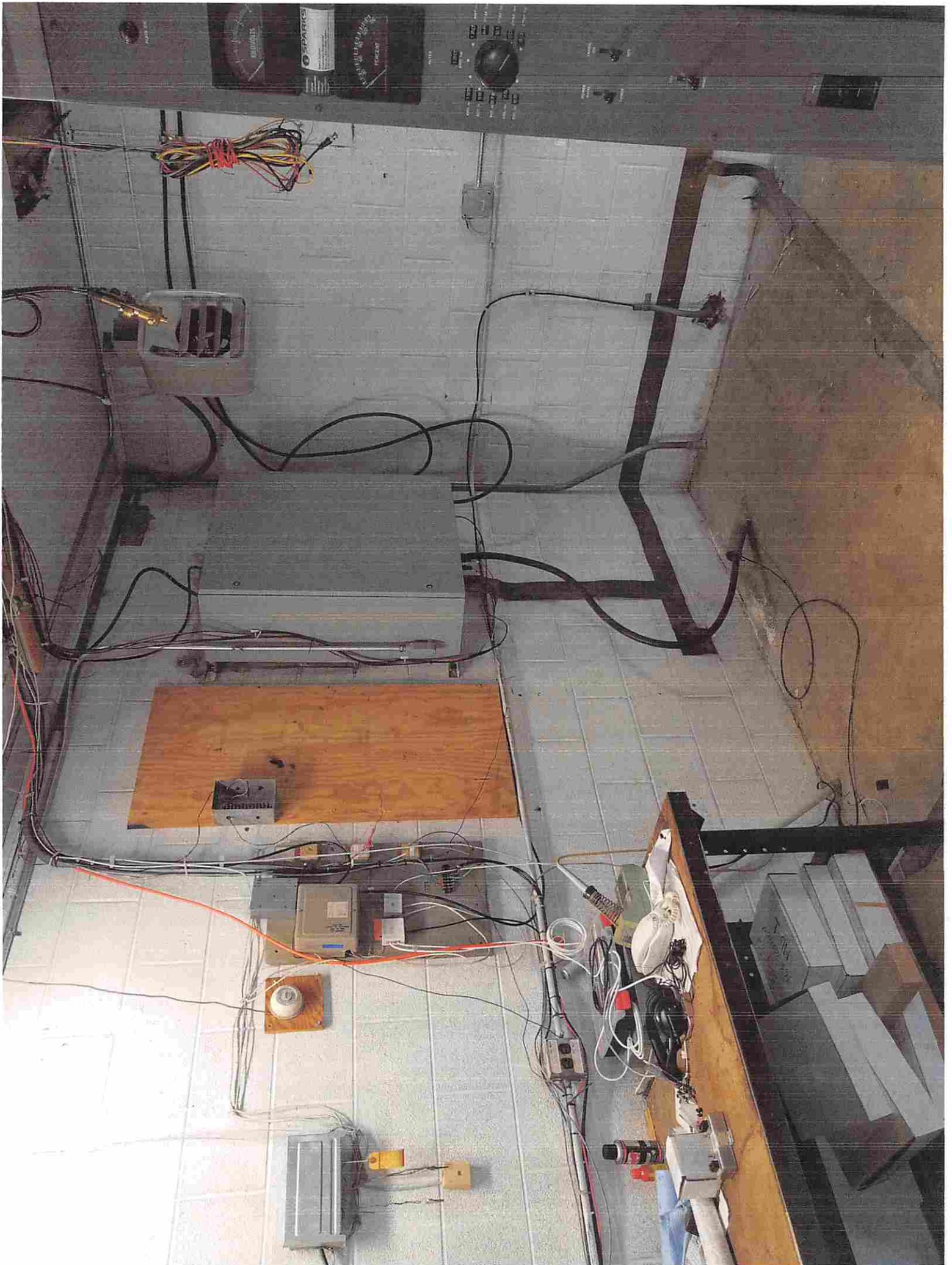

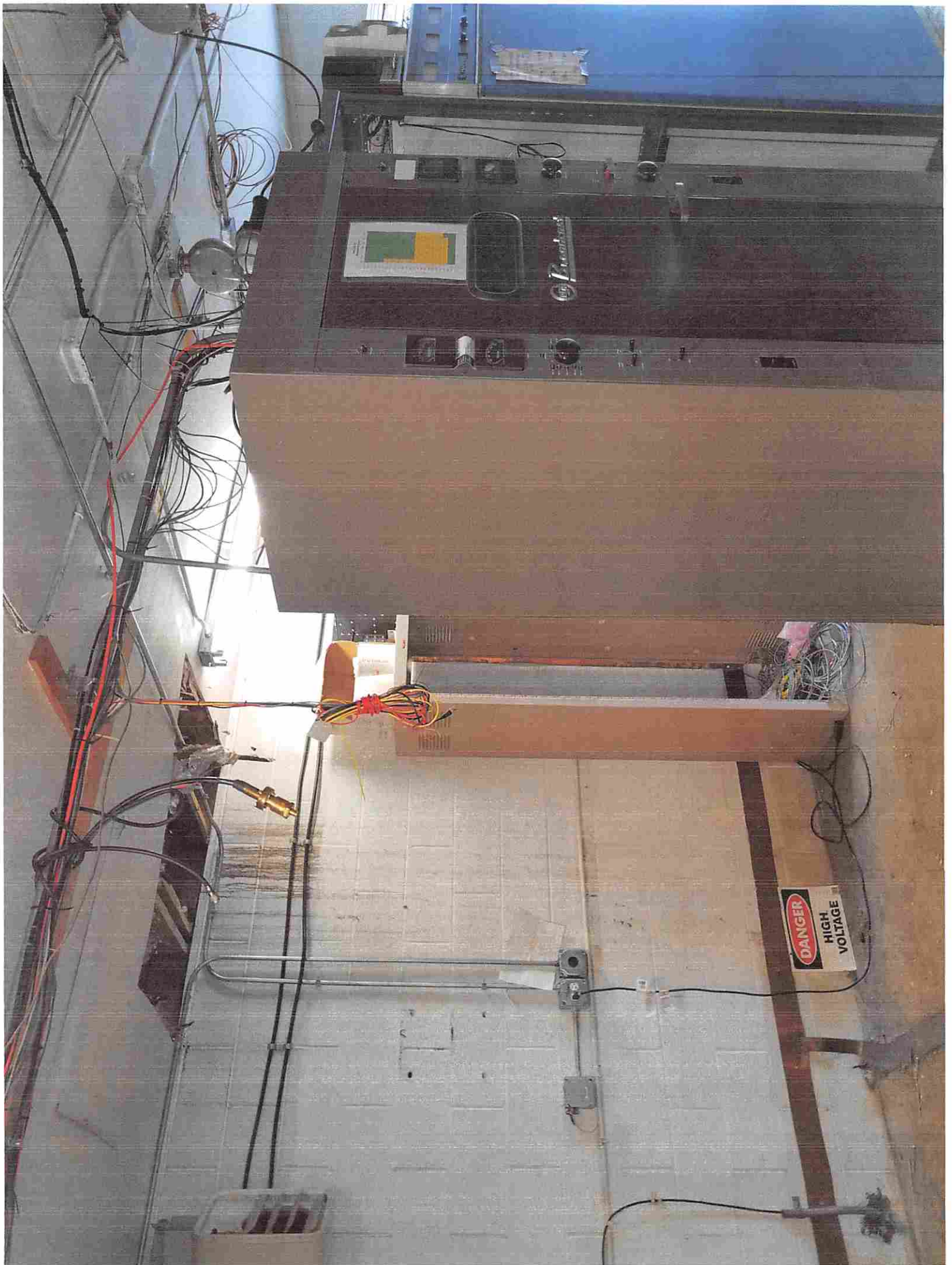
