ENGINEERING STATEMENT

The engineering data contained herein have been prepared on behalf of FOX TELEVISION STATIONS, INC., licensee of WFXT-DT, Channel 31 in Boston, Massachusetts, in support of its Application for Construction Permit to operate a post-transition auxiliary facility.

It is proposed to utilize the presently licensed Shively directional antenna mounted at the 328-meter level of the existing 366-meter tower. Exhibit B provides azimuth and elevation pattern data for the existing antenna. Exhibit C is a map upon which the predicted service contours of the WFXT-DT allotment facility and the proposed auxiliary facility are plotted. As shown, the auxiliary's 41 dBu contour is completely contained within that of the allotment facility assigned to WFXT-DT in Appendix B of the Commission's DTV Table of Allotments. As a result, and since this proposal is for an auxiliary facility, an interference study is not provided. A power density calculation appears in Exhibit D.

It is not expected that the proposed facility would cause objectionable interference to any other broadcast or non-broadcast station authorized to operate at or near the WFXT-DT site. However, if such should occur, the owner of this station recognizes its obligation to take whatever corrective actions are necessary.

Since no change in overall height or location of the existing tower is proposed herein, the FAA has not been notified of this application. In addition, the FCC issued Antenna Structure Registration Number 1004233 to this tower.
