Dear Mr. Williams:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 14, 2021. CHMG requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 28, 2018, to continue operating with nighttime parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.¹ In support of the request, CHMG states that additional time is needed to resolve all remaining issues, including a possible reradiation problem on the 28 degree monitored radial (and perform a partial proof due to sampling system repairs).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CHMG may continue to operate with nighttime parameters at variance and reduced power to maintain all nighttime monitor points within licensed limits, with no change to the licensed daytime operation. CHMG must reduce nighttime power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47

¹ WCHL(AM) is licensed for operation on 1360 kHz with 5 kW ND day and 1 kW DA night.

CFR §1.1310. CHMG must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed to update all operating parameters, or the date the station was able to resumed licensed operations per BZ-19880512AL with negligible changes.

This authority expires on **July 2, 2022**.
