**Amendment**


The purpose of this amendment is to address the multiple ownership issues pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §73.3555(b). An entity may control two television stations in the same DMA if the Grade B contours of the two stations do not overlap.

KBJN is included in the vast Salt Lake City, Utah DMA. Sierra Broadcasting Company (“Sierra”) is the licensee of KENV, Channel 10, Elko, Nevada [Facility # 63845]. Sierra and Valley Broadcasting Company (“Valley”) are subsidiaries of Sunbelt Communications Company (“Sunbelt”). Elko, Nevada is located approximately 120 miles Northwest of Ely, Nevada. Neither KENV nor KBJN operate facilities with overlapping Grade B contours. Both stations operate at reduced power levels because the area is sparsely populated and is concentrated around the two communities. The predicted Grade B coverage area shown on the attached map for either station does not overlap.

KENV and KBJN operate as satellites from two separate stations in two different DMAs. KENV rebroadcasts programming from KRNK, Channel 4, Reno, Nevada (Reno DMA). KBJN rebroadcasts programming from KVBC, Channel 3, Las Vegas, Nevada (Las Vegas, DMA).

In addition to the amendment, Valley will simultaneously file a Broadcasting Equal Employment Opportunity Model Report (FCC Form 396-A).
